

**Consideration of Appointment of Replacement Members to the Advisory
Committee on Licensure, Eligibility, and Discipline**

Summary of Request: Consider the appointment of Cheryl Livengood, MSN, RN, and the re-appointment of Betty Sims, MSN, RN, FRE to the Advisory Committee on Licensure, Eligibility, and Discipline (Committee).

Background: 22 Tex. Admin. Code §211.6(f)(2) permits the Board to amend committee memberships as needed. Christine Rios-Irizarry, RN, BSN is currently a member of the Committee, representing the Texas Association of Vocational Nurse Educators (TAVNE). Ms. Sims is currently a member of the Committee, representing the Texas Organization of Associate Degree Nurses (TOADN).

Ms. Rios-Irizarry will be relocating out of the country in March 2014 and will no longer be able to participate in the Committee. Ms. Sims is currently the president of TAVNE and has requested to take the place of Ms. Rios-Irizarry on the Committee, as the representative of TAVNE. Ms. Sims is no longer actively involved in TOADN.

Because Ms. Sims is no longer actively involved in TOADN, Ms. Sims has requested that she be replaced on the Committee as the representative of TOADN. Ms. Livengood is the current president of TOADN and has requested to take the place of Ms. Sims on the Committee, as the representative of TOADN. Board Action: Move to approve the appointment of Ms. Livengood to the Advisory Committee on Licensure, Eligibility, and Discipline as a representative of TOADN and re-appoint Ms. Sims to the Advisory Committee on Licensure, Eligibility, and Discipline as a representative of TAVNE, effective immediately.
